SPIRIT OF REJECTION

The Bible tells us in 2Tim 2:4: "No good soldier in active service entangles himself in the affairs of his present state of existence, so that he may please the one who enlisted him as a soldier."

The word entangles means "to cause to become twisted together with or caught in".

One very powerful Tactic that the enemy uses is Rejection.

Rejection is defined as:

- 1. The act of refusing to accept, use or believe someone or something.
- 2. The act of not giving someone the love and attention they want and expect.

<u>Synonyms of rejection</u>: brush-off, shunning, abandonment, desertion, non-acceptance, disfavor, dismissing and spurning.

Actions or circumstances of life can cause rejection. Left unattended or unrecognized, they will open the door for a spirit of rejection to set up camp in our soul (mind, will and emotions).
